Team,

We are closely monitoring Hurricane Milton Category 4 as it approaches Florida. This storm poses a serious threat, particularly to the West Coast and Central regions, where evacuations are highly recommended. Flooding and heavy winds are predicted in areas along the east coast and in Jacksonville. Current projections indicate that Milton will make landfall south of Tampa as a major storm, maintaining hurricane strength as it moves across the state south of Orlando and exits into the Atlantic Ocean. Officials caution that slight deviations in conditions could alter its track, urging residents to stay vigilant for updates. The storm is forecasted to make landfall late Wednesday or early Thursday, with deteriorating weather conditions starting Wednesday morning. Storm surges could reach up to 15 feet along the western coast of Florida.

A state of emergency for 51 counties is in place, emphasizing the importance of following evacuation orders. There are shelters in all counties check with your local government for information. Airports are canceling all flights, if you have travel plans, please check before heading to the airport. Highways are full, traffic is heavy, please drive carefully if you are trying to get somewhere else.

Please prioritize your safety and that of your families. Complete any preparations by Tuesday, stay alert for hazardous conditions, and maintain close communication with your managers. For assistance, contact our Employee Emergency Hotline or visit our website.
