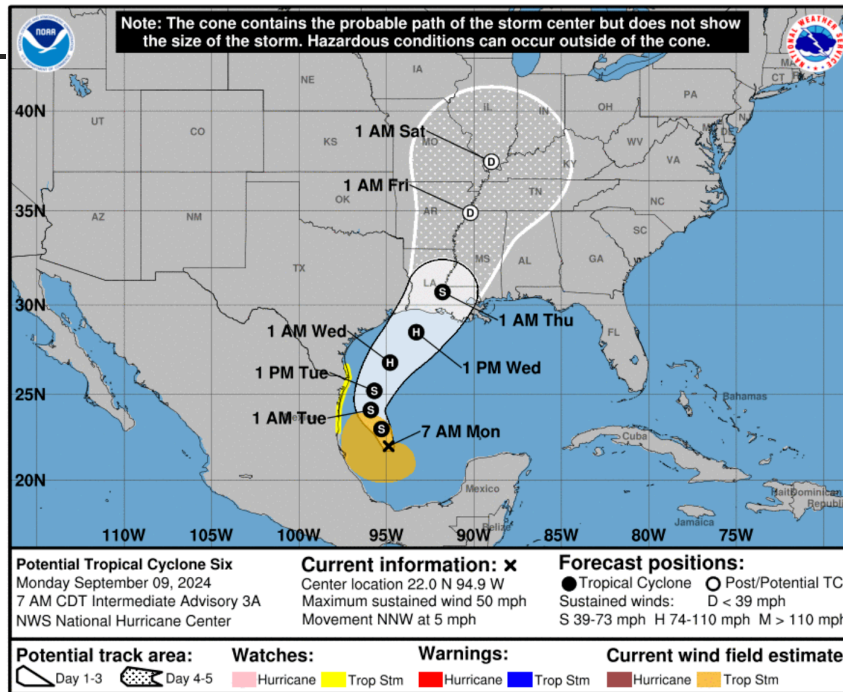

Subject: IMPORTANT: MONITORING TROPICAL CYCLONE SIX IN THE GULF OF MEXICO

This email is being sent on behalf of Bernie Reagan, Director of Emergency Response



Team,

We are currently monitoring a disturbance in the Gulf of Mexico, heading towards the eastern border of Texas, and making landfall in Louisiana. The system may bring heavy rainfall to portions of the area on Tuesday and Wednesday. However, impacts from wind, seas, coastal flooding, and rainfall remain uncertain due to uncertainties in the track forecast. This storm is expected to turn into a hurricane before making landfall in the northwest Gulf on Wednesday.

Given the anticipated winds and storm surge along the coastlines, comprehensive readiness is paramount. Your thorough review of the 2024 Hurricane Checklist, attached, is to confirm our collective state of preparedness.

We will keep you posted throughout the next few days if the storm intensifies or changes direction.
