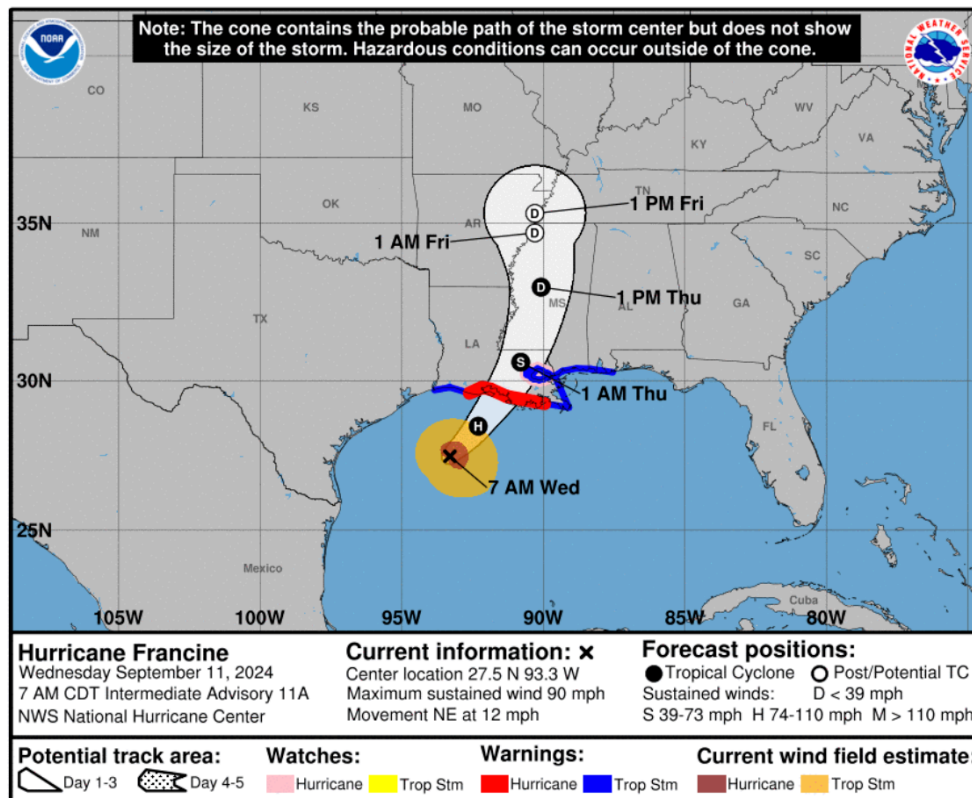

Subject: IMPORTANT UPDATE ON HURRICANE FRANCINE

Good morning,

I hope everyone is managing the current conditions of Hurricane Francine, which will make landfall later this evening in Louisiana. Moran Port Arthur, Moran New Orleans, and Moran LNG facilities in Lake Charles and Freeport will be effected by heavy winds, torential rainfall and flooding. Dangerous storm surges of 6 to 10 feet will impact the Gulf Coast, so please be sure to follow your local advisory warnings.

This storm also carries the potential for tornadoes. It's wise to activate Emergency Phone Alerts from your local government to receive immediate warnings about any potential dangers. This storm is expected to bring dangerous weather conditions into Mississippi, Alabama, Florida Panhandle, as well heading north into Tennessee and Kentucky. Please stay indoors and avoid the risks posed by flying debris, fallen trees, and flooding.
